Did you ever wonder about the statement of Jesus in Mark 11:24, where He said, “Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours” (ESV)? Jesus seems to be giving Christians a “blank check” for prayer.

After all, He had just cursed the fruitless fig tree and it withered (and probably died). He then promised His disciples that they could cast mountains into the sea, if they only believed without doubting. He followed up with a “*whatever* you ask.”
